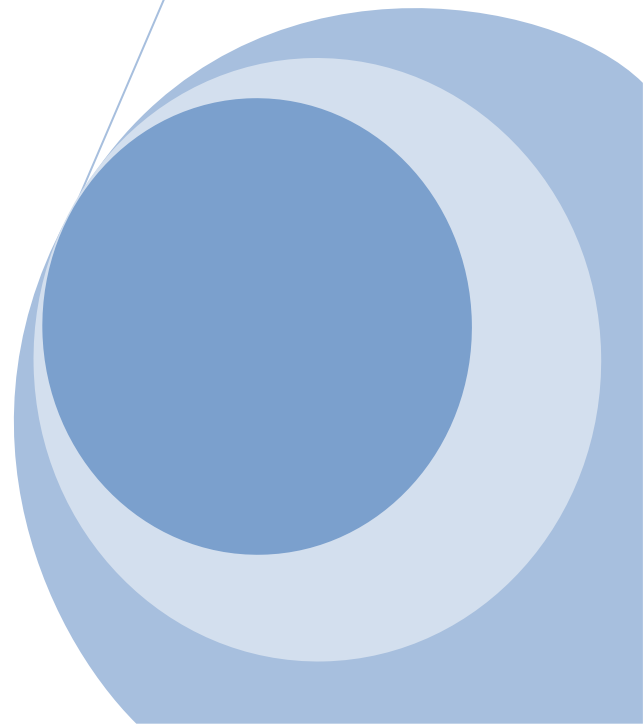
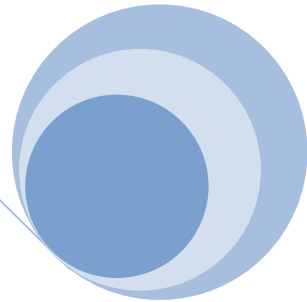
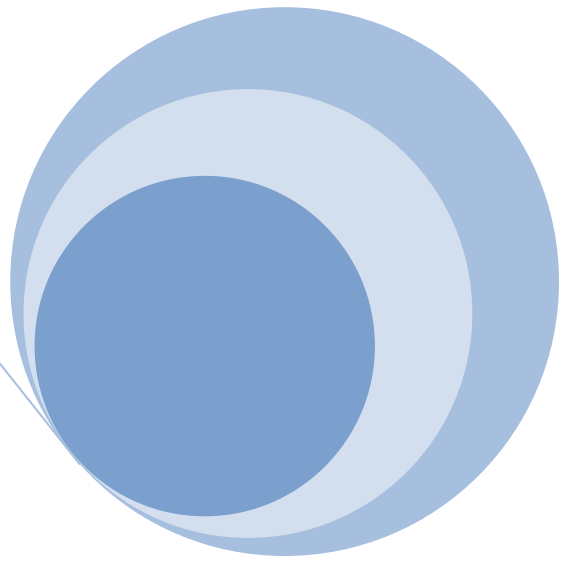


**Saturday Success Academy  
2010-2011**



**Description**

Success Academy consists of three hour Saturday sessions with a focus on remediation and enrichment activities in reading, mathematics, science, and writing. These sessions are to be made available to as many eligible students as possible (grade 3-10 students who are Level 1 and 2 in reading and mathematics, high school re-takers, and the top 45% grade 5, 8 and 11 science students).

The *Success Academy* is funded through several grants awarded to Miami-Dade County Public Schools and is offered at no cost to parents.

8:00 a.m. - 12 noon for teachers

9:00 a.m. - 12 noon for students

**Success Academy Dates**

\*Retakers can attend any of these thirteen sessions provided schools do not overspend their Success Academy Allocation.

**Program:**

- Tutoring and enrichment services will be provided to students in the areas of reading, mathematics, science, and writing.
- Services will be provided by highly qualified teachers, defined as: certified in the area and level of assignment; National Board Certified; reading endorsed, or possessing 3 or more years of teaching experience with acceptable teacher evaluations for each of the years.
- Teachers will be paid their hourly rate.
- Class-size will be 1:10

**Supervising Administrator Responsibilities**

- Orientation
- Reporting of attendance to the region office at the end of every session
- Reproduction of lessons and provision of materials to teachers
- Supervision of fidelity of implementation to the program's lessons
- Facility Plan:
  - ✓ Security Personnel
  - ✓ Custodial Supervision
  - ✓ Administrative Supervision

**Allocations**

- Hourly teachers (1:10)
- 3-Lead Instructors to train/support staff (Reading/Mathematics/Science)
- Assistant Principal (1 per site)
- Security monitor (2 per site)
- Custodian (2 per site)

**Student Membership**

Submit student membership by no later than 11:00 a.m. on each Saturday to your line Director. Student membership will be reported to the Superintendent each Saturday.

**Attendance Procedures**

Schools must maintain good record keeping of the students who participate in Saturday Success Academy. Use same procedures as those used during any other tutorial services provided to students. The electronic gradebook will not be used to keep attendance during this academy.

**Transportation**

Transportation may be considered for students whose residence is located more than two miles from their home school utilizing specific transportation stop locations established for the Success Academy. Each participating school principal will make requests for transportation through their respective Region as needed. Dr. Marcos Moran, Assistant Superintendent will work with Region Superintendents to coordinate this effort.

**Food Service**
