

Utilizing funds made available for serving co-enrolled students, the District has implemented an aggressive credit recovery program for senior high school students. Co-enrolled students are those students simultaneously enrolled in adult education and the traditional K-12 system. Targeted courses are offered during the summer thus utilizing the resources of both delivery systems. The opportunity to recover credits outside the typical school day and calendar enhances the graduation rate.
