SAFE SCHOOLS DATA

The safety of all students within Miami-Dade County Public Schools is a primary concern in our district and a shared responsibility between students, parents, staff and the community. Our global focus is on both the prevention and intervention of crisis situations. To that end, we have established a District Crisis Team that is available to provide daily consultation for school site staff who are navigating crisis situations such as students with suicidal/homicidal ideations, threats, gestures, and attempts; as well as self-injurious behaviors and other serious self-defeating behaviors. The Crisis Team is also asked with the coordination of school site crisis responses for unfortunate incidents such as the death of a student or staff member Grief counseling and specialized support services are provided for students, families, and staff. The following data represents the work of the District Crisis Team from 2007-2011:

All bullying/harassment investigations are recorded in our district database with the investigation outcomes of either *founded* or *unfounded*.
