To report Bullying and Harassment:

- 1. On-Line using an anonymous reporting form available on the Mental Health and Crisis Management Services website.
- 2. Calling the Bullying Hotline: 305-995-CARE
- 3. Using the anonymous reporting system called BE SAFE:
 - Texting
 - On-Line
 - Phone: 305-995-COPS
- 4. All schools have an anonymous bullying reporting box located in a discrete location (Main office) for students, staff, parents and all visitors.

(All schools received posters in 3 languages advertising the District Policy Against Bullying and Harassment)

To report any concerns about school safety, use BE SAFE anonymous reporting system:

1. Texting: Using cell phones, a text message is sent to 274637 (CRIMES) with the text message beginning with the keyword "BESAFE"; followed by the anonymous tip.

School Police and the Office of Mental Health and Crisis Management Services both receive these anonymous tips and respond accordingly depending on the nature of the tip. This allows for shared communication, immediate responses, and collaborative interventions.
